

Using the Paddlers Supply LED Decklight

The Paddlers Supply LED Decklight is intended as a “positioning light”.

It is similar to an anchor light on larger vessel. It is intended to notify others on the water of your position. It will shine a bright LED white light 360 degrees around and indicate your location to others on the water. If you are paddling at dusk or in a group, it will increase the safety of being on the water and increases the chances of boaters to see your location.

- The LED Decklight should be mounted on the stern (rear, behind the cockpit or seat) of your kayak or SUP. You do not want to mount the light in front of you or the cockpit, as it would reduce your own vision of your surroundings.
- It will need a smooth surface for the suction cup to form a good suction.
- Always make sure you use the attached tether to connect the light to decklines or bungees on your kayak or SUP.
- The Paddlers Supply LED Decklight uses 3AA batteries to provide power for up to 100 hours. The 2 LED bulbs will last about 10,000 hours.
- The light turns on with a twist of the top shade of the light.
- Two O-rings make allow it to be waterproof whether in an on or off position.
- After every use the LED Decklight should be disassembled in order to let any condensation dry out from the inside. (Even though it is waterproof condensation can form inside of any enclosed electronics, any items that you use in marine situations should be opened to allow the item completely dry.)
- The batteries should be removed if you are storing the LED Decklight for any longer period of time.
